ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY

Library

The University library, stacked with the latest editions of books, magazines and journals, is a Temple of Learning, which is efficiently managed by our librarians. It has a collection of 54,474 Indian and foreign books, besides 335 journals and 326 magazines. The whole library is computerized with bar coding facility.

Sports

The University promotes various sports activities for the students. The management also provides Sports Quota for students excelling in certain disciplines. Two Physical Fitness Centres (Gym), Human Performance Laboratory, 400 m track, Hockey Field, Football court, Hand ball court, Volley ball complex, Basketball court, Kabadi courts and two indoor badminton courts are established.

NSS Unit

The National Service Scheme was started in our University during 1996 (Karpagam Arts and Science) with a sanction of one unit. Another unit was sanctioned in the academic year 2002-2003. The third unit was introduced in 2004-05. Every year a special camp is conducted for 10 days in the nearby villages for each unit separately. Many programmes like eye camps, blood donation camps, AIDS awareness camps and guest lectures are conducted. Necessary steps have been taken to inculcate among the students the dignity of labour and the importance of social service having in mind the need for societal development. The main aims of NSS are self discipline, hard work and the feeling of oneness with the poor and the down trodden.

Laboratories

Seventeen fully air-conditioned Computer laboratories occupy 3000 sq. mt. area. There are 12 main servers and 1418 nodes. The software installed includes, Windows 2003 Server, Windows 2000 Professional, Linux, NT Server & Workstations, Office XP 2003, MS Visual Studio 6.0, Java and Multimedia Kit, Net and Oracle, Windows XP, .Visual. Net, J2EE, Oracle 10G and LCD, CADENCE, ANSYS, CAD, CAM.

The Life Science Department (Microbiology, Biotechnology, Industrial Biotechnology, Bioinformatics, Biochemistry) has 11 laboratories, with

instrumentation rooms, which provide opportunities for students to carry out research in the modern trends and, an animal house approved by the Government of India.

The Basic and Applied Sciences stream (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Electronic and Communication Systems) has well equipped laboratories.

For Catering Science Department there are two Basic Training Kitchens, a Quantity Training Kitchen, a Bakery Unit, a Basic Training Restaurant, a Specialty Restaurant, Front Office and a model guest room with star hotel facilities for House- Keeping.

The Faculty of Engineering has 50 laboratories with latest software for modeling and simulation, testing and measuring equipments and special instruments for research.

The Faculty of Architecture is established with computer lab, dedicated library and two drawing studios, Lecture halls with audio visual facilities.

The Karpagam University Instrumentation Centre (KUIC) established in 2010 caters to the needs of all research students. Regular training programme in instrumentation techniques are organized.

Counselling for Students

To help the students to overcome certain difficulties, both personal and academic, students counseling and guidance services are provided by the University.

Career Development and Corporate Relation

Department of Career Development and Corporate Relation is constituted to educate students on the Higher Education in India and abroad. The students are provided with assistance on career development and training offered at the corporate level.

Placement and Training Cell

The Placement and Training Department in the University campus provides corporate, need based training to the students to equip them with skills necessary to get placed. The training modules cover Aptitude training, Communicative English, Technical Training and Personality Development programmes which start from pre-final year onwards. Training is conducted by the experienced staff of the University as well as by outside professionals. The training helps the students to get placed in

leading companies. Many on campus interviews are conducted and the campus has an excellent track record of placement for all departments. Companies like Infosys, Wipro, Dr. Reddy's laboratories, Novaris, Bio-con, Eureka Forbes, ABN Amro Bank, HDFC Bank, Airtel, Aircel, ING Vysya Insurance, and Max NewLife have conducted recruitments at the campus. During 2010-11, 659 students were placed in many leading companies.

Research

The University encourages research. The students and researchers are deputed to Seminars / Symposia / Conferences / Workshops / Training programmes in their specialized discipline. The Department of Research and International Relations is devoting fully in conducting research and establishing collaboration with Industries, Institutions in India and other Countries. Research Fellowships are awarded to meritorious fulltime research scholars. Best projects are financially supported. Annual Research congress is held every year during December first week.

Hostel

The hostel functions separately for boys and girls, providing a homely atmosphere with delicious vegetarian food, served hygienically.

Internet

A 10 Mbps lease line Internet facility is available in our University for 24 hrs, providing online service for students and staff. The campus is made Wifi.

The moulding of character is at the top of the agenda and since the behaviour of the students will make or mark the reputation of the institution, the students are advised to scrupulously abide by the following rules and regulations.

It is mandatory for all the students to possess their identity card always duly attested by the Registrar. Identity cards will be issued to the students soon after their admission into the University. The students have to produce the ID Cards on demand by the authorities of the University. The possession of identity cards is all the more essential at the time of Examinations.

RAGGING

As per the UGC regulations on curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institution, 2009 (Under Section 26(1) (g) of the UGC Act, 1956) and Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997, Ragging means display of noisy, disorderly conduct of doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes (a) teasing, abusing of, playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to such student or (b) asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course, willingly do. The Act prohibits ragging within or outside any educational institution. **Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates, abets or propagates ragging** shall be punished with imprisonment for a term, which may extend to THREE years and shall be liable to a fine, which may extend to Rs. 25,000/-

Any student convicted of an offence under the section 4 shall also be **dismissed** from the educational institution and such students shall not be admitted in any other educational institution. The decision of the Board of Management shall be final.

Behaviour





It is imperative on the part of the students to attend the classes, functions and any other extra and co-curricular activities regularly and punctually.





Students are expected to dress neatly and to follow the approved dress code. Girls are expected to be either in saree or churidhar or salwar kameez with duppatta.


Boys are expected to come in full pants with bush shirt. Round neck T-shirt with or without any message, Jeans and Short shirts are not allowed. Boys shall not wear ear rings, bangles or similar items. Girl students shall tie their hair properly.


 The students shall wear the I.D cards. Without ID cards, they shall not be allowed inside class room/ examination hall.


 Students must occupy their seats in the respective classes well before the lecturers enter the classes. When a lecturer enters the class, the students shall stand up in their places as a mark of respect.


 Latecomers will not be permitted inside the classroom without the permission slip from the Head of the Department concerned or the Registrar.


 Students should not absent themselves from the University without applying for leave. Those students who could not attend classes on medical grounds must produce a medical certificate along with the leave letter.


 Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the campus. Students found using intoxicants and drugs will be summarily dismissed.


 Incase of cancellation of a class, students shall be in the library.


 Students should refrain from participating in any kind of political or communal activities.


 Students found guilty of damaging, destroying University property should replace the same at their own cost.


 Students should not sit on the parapet walls or on the steps or staircases.

 Students found guilty of writing, scribbling, painting on the walls, desks etc., will be penalized suitably with fine.

 Students must identify those who cause damage to the University property and report to the Registrar.

 Outsiders will not be permitted to meet the students during working hours.

 Students found guilty of using foul language or behaving rudely towards the staff members, will be expelled from the University.

 Any requisition or letter written by the student to the Registrar should be sent through the tutor and the H O D concerned.



Eve-teasers will be dismissed from the University.

Keeping and/or using the cell phone inside the University campus is prohibited. Hostellers are permitted to use within the hostel premises before or after the silent hours. The cell phone will be confiscated if found in use and is returned only after the completion of the course.

Attendance

Attendance shall be considered semester wise (not annually).

All the students are expected to attend classes everyday without fail. However, if there are some important and genuine reasons students can avail leave after obtaining permission from the respective class Tutor and HOD/ Dean.

- 1. The attendance of the students is marked every hour.**
- 2. If a student is absent for one or more hours in a session (forenoon or afternoon), he /she will lose attendance for half-a-day.**
- 3. The working days for a semester are 90 days.**
- 4. To appear for the University examination a student has to**
 - a) Earn 75% of attendance for each semester**
 - b) Satisfy the University by his / her conduct and progress.**
- 5. If the student has secured less than 75% of attendance, the student has to redo the course. However the student will be permitted to appear for arrear examinations.**

On duty attendance

1. Students involved in Co & Extra-Curricular activities and hence missing regular classes should contact the respective authorities (Physical Director/NSS Officers/HODs/Faculty in charge for various activities) who will recommend the case to the Registrar for attendance within four working days. After four working days, the request will not be considered.
2. Students must obtain written permission from the Registrar before undertaking these activities, and on completion of the activities, they must submit a prescribed application form to the Registrar to claim the on duty attendance.

Leave

1. Students should apply for leave to the respective class tutor / adviser and HOD before availing leave.
2. If leave is requested for reasons of illness for more than two days, the leave application along with a medical certificate should be submitted by the parents / local guardian on or before the 3rd day of illness. A fitness certificate from the Doctor who treated the student should be submitted on the day of rejoining the University.

Note: Submission of leave application with/without medical certificate does not entitle a student to earn attendance for the days of his/her absence.

FEE REGULATIONS

In an academic year, payment of fees is divided into two semesters. The first semester commences from the reopening of the University in June, after the summer vacation and continues till the end of October. The second semester commences from the middle of November to the end of March.

1. Every student is liable to pay the whole fees for each semester. The fees should be paid within the indicated date.
2. Students who do not pay the fees on or before the last date indicated shall pay a fine as may be imposed by the University.

CERTIFICATES

Any student who wishes to obtain a Transfer or Conduct Certificate shall apply to the University office in writing. Certificates will be issued the next day only.

Students representing the University in various activities should get bonafide certificates from the Registrar.






Malpractices in Examinations:

1. Candidates scribbling on the question paper will be sent out of the examination hall.
2. Candidates found in possession of material in the form of printed / Photostat / cyclostyled / handwritten or in any other means i.e., written on paper, cloth, scale, furniture, hand/body etc., will be penalized.
3. Candidates found copying from the incriminating materials owned or borrowed in any form mentioned in Rule 2 or from the answer book of another candidate or abetting another candidate to copy will be penalized.
4. Inserting previously written answer sheets brought from outside, aiding or assisting for copying from additional book pilfered already or passing on written bits for copying is liable to be penalized.
5. Candidates refusing to accompany the Hall Superintendent to the Chief Superintendent or to the Registrar on account of his / her malpractice or exhibiting verbal resistance inside or outside the examination hall or running out of the hall with or without the answer paper or script will be penalized.
6. Candidates should not leave the hall within 45 minutes from the time of commencement of examination, with or without Question / Answer paper.
7. Candidate employing somebody to write examination will be penalized.
8. **Cell phones/pagers are not permitted in the Exam Halls. If any student is found possessing a cell phone/pager in the examination hall, the cell phone/pager will be seized and will be returned to the student at the time of leaving the University with TC.**
9. The Candidates will be permitted to enter the Exam Hall within 30 minutes.










Note: The above are only guidelines and any other malpractice not covered under any clause above shall be suitably dealt with.

Library Rules:


1. Students are advised to avail the library facilities to the best use. The library will be kept open between **8 am** and **8 pm** on all working days and between **9 am** to **5 pm** on all Saturdays.
2. Strict silence should be observed in the library.
3. Any type of damage to the books must be strictly avoided.
4. The following rules will be administered while issuing books to the students.

-  Each UG and PG Student is entitled to borrow two and four books respectively from the library (except reference books and periodicals) and the books will be issued on production of identity card of the student.
-  A book borrowed from the library must be returned within 15 days failing which, a fine of Rs. 1/- day will be imposed.
-  The students are expected to check the books for any damage while borrowing and report the same at once, failing which, they will be held responsible for the damage.
-  If a book is lost by a student, he/she must replace the book or pay double the cost of the book.
-  The students are advised not to take books from their account and lend it to their friends

Hostel Rules:

-  Compulsory study, silence hours will be maintained between 8.30 pm to 10.30 pm. During the silence hours the students are expected to be in the rooms allotted to them.
-  No student will be permitted to leave the hostel without prior written permission from the warden.
-  Parents / relations will be allowed to meet the students between 4.30 pm and 6.30 pm.
-  While admitting the students in the hostel, the parents must give the names of the visitors with whom the students can go out.
-  The students should not damage the hostel property.
-  No student should bring day scholars inside the hostel.
-  Smoking, drinking, playing cards totally prohibited.
-  Mobile phones will be seized if used from 8.30 pm to 10.30 pm (during silence / study hours) and will be returned only after the completion of the course.
-  Any kind of misbehavior in the hostel will lead to immediate expulsion from the hostel and the University.

Important Days to Remember

-  The students are instructed to pay the University fees within **ten days** from the commencement of that semester.
